## THE PROPOSITION, QUESTION OR HYPOTHESIS:

- What we did was: 3D – printing, thermo painting, we combined both and created hexagram shape piece with conductive yarn, which could change color
- Why we decided to do this experiment was because: it was interesting to combine two different techniques and find out how this works
- How we conducted the work the process or sequences: first we decided what form will be and how it could connect with other pieces. Then using program we created model, meantime Riikka was experimenting with paintings on 3d printed pieces. Then the pieces were cooked we started paint it, then put inside yarns and see results.
- The main challenges we encountered were: get the right working form system and adhesion of thermo paintings on plastic surfaces.
- What we achieved was: see that colour changing works also on different surfaces and plastic is good one.
